But LAST is "most important" in most lists even in our human writings.... and God's last sin listed is "Whoever loves and practices a lie." // **So what was the first sin?** It was NOT "biting into a piece of fruit".... Jesus said it in John 8:44 Satan. the father of lies. committed the first sin in recorded history as directed by the Holy Spirit guiding Moses to write in Genesis 3: **He LIED by saying that GOD lied.... GOSSIPINGS against the LORD Almighty Lying is AN EVIL thing in God's eyes....** He guided David the Psalmist to write about it in Psalm 41....
