(New KJV)

The Glory of God in Zion - A Song. A Psalm of the sons of Korah.

- 1 Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised In the city of our God, In His holy mountain.
- 2 Beautiful in elevation, The joy of the whole earth, Is Mount Zion on the sides of the north,
The city of the great King.
- 3 God is in her palaces; He is known as her refuge.
- 4 For behold, the kings assembled, They passed by together.
- 5 They saw it, and so they marveled; They were troubled, they hastened away.
- 6 Fear took hold of them there, And pain, as of a woman in birth pangs,
- 7 As when You break the ships of Tarshish With an east wind.
- 8 As we have heard, So we have seen In the city of the LORD of hosts,
In the city of our God: God will establish it forever. Selah
- 9 We have thought, O God, on Your lovingkindness, In the midst of Your temple.
- 10 According to Your name, O God, So is Your praise to the ends of the earth;
Your right hand is full of righteousness. 11 Let Mount Zion rejoice,
Let the daughters of Judah be glad, Because of Your judgments.
- 12 Walk about Zion, And go all around her. Count her towers;
- 13 Mark well her bulwarks; Consider her palaces;
That you may tell it to the generation following.
