**READING Psalm 49:** 5-13a, 15 NLT - Why should I fear when trouble comes, when enemies surround me? They trust in their wealth and boast of great riches. Yet **they cannot redeem themselves** from death by paying a ransom to God. Redemption does not come so easily, for **no one can ever pay enough to live forever and never see the grave.** Those who are wise must finally die, just like the foolish and senseless, leaving all their wealth behind. The grave is their **eternal** home, where they will stay **forever**. They may name their estates after themselves, but their fame will not last. They will die, just like animals..... 13a This is the **fate of fools**...

**15 But as for me, God will redeem my life. He will snatch me from the power of the grave.**
