**Psalm 49: 5** Why should I fear when trouble comes, when enemies surround me? They trust in their wealth and boast of great riches. **Yet they cannot redeem themselves** from death **by paying a ransom to God**. Redemption does not come so easily, for **no one can ever pay enough to live forever and never see the grave**. Those who are wise must finally die, just like the foolish and senseless, leaving all their wealth behind. The grave is their eternal home, where they will stay forever. They may name their estates after themselves, but their fame will not last. They will die, just like animals. **13 This is the fate of fools... 15 But as for me, God will redeem my life. He will snatch me from the power of the grave. So don't be dismayed** when the wicked grow rich and their homes become ever more splendid. For when they die, they take nothing with them. Their wealth will not follow them into the grave. In this life they consider themselves fortunate and are applauded for their success. But they will die like all before them and never again see the light of day....
