Reading after Verse 3 (interlude before chorus)

Praise To God through Psalm 71, GRAYING PRAISING, verses 5 through 8. For You have been my hope, Sovereign LORD, my confidence since my youth. From birth I have relied on You; You brought me forth from my mother's womb. I will ever praise You. I have become a sign to many; You are my strong refuge. My mouth is filled with Your praise, declaring Your splendor all day long.
