Song Story. Written into my traveling temporary leather Journal 33 that I keep in the car... because it was all I had to write in when I was brought to the hospital with a serious illness 3 days earlier, when the doctors did not know what was causing a deadly blood infection, 50% survival rate- when I did not know if God was closing this chapter of my life in preparation for life in His presence. Written with an excited eagerness to format a few more of God's Bible psalms into a song format for the website He led me to be able to populate with almost 500 recorded songs and un-counted lyrics setups or music sheets not yet recorded... Quite at Peace, whatever His choice. As 1 of my first 5 songs with Him says: "I CHOOSE YOUR CHOICE." Typed 6 weeks later.... God gave me more time this time - Music 3 years later.
