The odd quirk in timing in Bridge was from a timing mistake that showed up when I quantized those measures in my studio program-- and decided that I liked the quirk. Each time I goof, I do examine before fixing just in case it's another inspiration from God -- as many odd features in His songs have been! **Lyrics** inspired by Shabbat HEBREW word study from previous week, God says in Jeremiah 2:22 (1) You cannot remove your sins with soap or acid (potash)- That is: **"You NEED a Savior!"... AND (2) your iniquity is "marked" before Me= usual translation. But Hebrew for "marked" can actually be "Carved" or... "ENGRAVED"!**... SEE "engraved" as a HAPPY word -- PROMISES from LORD God! -- in Isaiah 49:16 (read all of 49) & John 10:28!
