### VERSE 1

"In God I Trust." I know that I MUST <u>NOT</u> add an "If God does THIS." In God I trust when I don't understand. FAITH has confidence in God's Plan.

#### **CHORUS**

God IS Truth. He cannot lie.

Trust God without any **IF**s.

Satan is the Father of Lies. John 8: 44 -- Jesus said THIS.

FAITH will always **trust** Yahweh\* God's goodness.

(Isaiah 42:8, Hebrew)

## VERSE 2

READING 1 after vs 2: Jesus speaking in John 8:42-47 about Genesis 3 being TRUE history of Satan lying about God to Eve in the garden of Eden: Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me. 43 Why do you not understand My speech? Because you are not able to listen to My word. 44 You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it. But because I tell the truth, you do not believe Me. 46 Which of you convicts Me of sin? And if I tell the truth, why do you not believe Me? 47 He who is of God hears God's words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God."

#### VERSE 3

**READING 2 at END:** John 10: 9-11, Jesus compares Satan to Himself: I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly. "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep. > Reading 1 on page 1 (John 15).

In John 15: **JESUS said that we are His friends** \*<u>IF</u>\* **we obey Him**. There's <u>NO</u> <u>exception</u> for **IF** we don't understand His will **or** don't like where **obedience** may take us.
