### Song Story.

When I was began high school, all the "popular" girls had sweet high voices. I was anything but popular, so I figured I'd try to sound like them. At home -- making sure my little brother wasn't around to laugh at me! -- I'd practice talking with a light high voice.

Not a successful experiment.

As an adult, I learned something intriguing when I began playing piano at the nursing home's weekly worship service -- None of the hard-of-hearing people had any trouble hearing my deep throated voice even when I spoke normally. Even more intriguing: In June 2006, I began daily prayers that God would improve my voice. Without me practicing enough to claim it was from anything but God's answering, my voice stretched from a low (bass) E (which I discovered while singing "Squeaky Wheel Praising") to a high F -- 26 half steps! Yet God still gives me a deep speaking voice that sounds so **soul-full when reading these sad scriptures of what we people do to Him.** Of how much we hurt Him. And ANGER Almighty God with human plottings to seek our selfish control over people.
