SCRIPTURES after each verse.

AFTER VS 1: Psalm 145: 18-19. "The LORD is near to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth. He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear their cry & save them."

AFTER VS 2: Jeremiah 17:5, 7: "Thus says the LORD: "Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength, Whose heart departs from the LORD... Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD, And whose hope is the LORD."

AFTER VS 3: Philippians 4:19: "God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus." – *which echoes what Jesus had already said repeatedly, Matthew 6:26, 28a:* "Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?... So why do you worry?"

AFTER VS 4: Isaiah 43: 1-2, "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called *you* by your name; You *are* Mine. **When you pass through the waters, I will be with you;** And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you."

Psalm 62. "Truly my soul silently waits for God; From Him comes my salvation. He only is my rock and my salvation, my stronghold; I shall not be greatly shaken." My soul, wait silently for God alone, *for my expectation is from Him. In God is my salvation and my glory; The rock of my strength, And my refuge, is in God.*
