SPOKEN WORDS 1: In Isaiah 41:10, God gives COMFORT to all who HONOR Him: "Do not fear for I AM with you. Do not anxiously look around you, for I AM your God. I will strengthen you, SURELY. I will help you."

Continuing PROMISE of God Named Yahweh*: "

SURELY. I will uphold you with My righteous right hand", promises God named YHWH--who IS the "I AM", as He told people He Was and IS, in Exodus 3:14.

* God gives His actual Name-- Y*H*W*H -- in Isaiah 42:6-8 and most places that translated His Name as His TITLE of "LORD".

ECHO: Because I AM your God.... Because I AM your God!

Through Isaiah 41:10, He gives us PEACE -- to ALL who HONOR Him.

"Do not fear for **I AM** with you.

Do not anxiously around you, for **I AM** your God.

I will strengthen you, SURELY. I will help you. SURELY.

I will uphold you with My righteous right hand", promises God named YHWH--

THE I AM -- as He told people He Was -- and IS Exodus 3: 14.

In Isaiah 43, God comforts ALL people >>> "1 But now, thus says the LORD, who created you, O Jacob, And He who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; You are Mine. 2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you.... 3 For I am the LORD <YHWH> your God, The Holy One of Israel, your Savior; ... 10 Before Me there was no God formed, Nor shall there be after Me. I, even I, am the LORD <YHWH>, And besides Me there is NO savior. I have declared and SAVED...."

ISAIAH 56 matches God's Word in Romans 11 -- God invites Gentiles (non-Jews) to be GRAFTED IN to His people ISRAEL... and to know that

these promises are for <u>ALL</u> who TRULY HONOR & <u>Obey</u> Him.

Song Story.

This scripture of Isaiah 41 gives SO much COMFORT -- But I kept FORGETTING parts of God's promises-- SO I wrote this song for myself as well as others-- with God's gifting of music in less than an Hour. We find MORE comfort is in Isaiah 43-- where God named YHWH clearly describes Himself as our ONLY Savior.

Ezekiel 34, God also called himself the GOOD SHEPHERD—which is why the religious leaders got so upset when Jesus called Himself that in John 10:11 AND 14. They *KNEW* that Jesus was saying that <u>He</u> was YHWH come to the earth as God Himself <u>PROPHESIED</u> in the latter scriptures before His 400 years of SILENCE when people would NOT listen to Him—Prophesied to COME TO DWELL AMONG US, in Zechariah 2:10 and 11 (as the Son—not the Father).

NOTE: See Isaiah 42: 8 where God clearly states His name in Hebrew without vowels, YHWH -- which is usually pronounced Yaw-Way.
